### Collegiate Scholarship Application

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In accordance with article X of our Constitution, applicants are eligible to apply for a scholarship to be used towards their tuition or books. Each applicant must provide proof that they are enrolled in a college and attach a copy of a paid tuition bill from the bursar's office with their request for their scholarship. Each application must also include a 500 word essay on how this scholarship would help them with their education. Students may elaborate on their educational pursuit or their education goals leading to a career.

In order to re-apply for a scholarship, the recipient or applicant that did not win, must simply follow the application procedure again. In addition, previous recipients must maintain at least a B average by the end of their first year and provide proof in the form of a report card. Re-application can be made yearly.

Upon receipt of proof of enrollment into college, our committee will confirm that information before marking that applicant eligible to apply. Upon selection, payments will be made directly to the college bursar's office and will contain the name of the applicant/student and their student ID number. It will state in an attached letter that the scholarship is to be applied toward tuition and fees, course related expenses such as books, supplies, and equipment. We would not expect the terms of our scholarship to be violated, given the procedure in place in order to apply. But if for any reason, the applicant applies under false pretenses or violated any terms, the recipient will be sent a certified letter demanding that payment be returned.

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
